

2020 DANCER CONTRACT

Springboard Danse through its Springboard Danse Montréal program would like to offer you the opportunity to live a professional experience with established dance companies and choreographers (referred to herein as the “project”). We will function as a company for the next three weeks. You are expected to attend all classes, workshops and rehearsals as assigned. This means if you are sick, injured or indisposed, you must contact the office in the morning before 10:00 am so that the proper individuals can be notified. As in many professional companies you will get a warning after one class missed without prior permission. After the second class or any rehearsal missed without permission, you will be asked to leave the project with no refund.

Once you are cast for the Principal Companies, Resident, and Emerging Choreographers participating in the project, it is a binding commitment and you must attend all rehearsals as scheduled.

Principal Companies, Resident, and Emerging Choreographers, in consultation with Springboard Danse, make all casting decisions and are responsible for all project matters. On occasion, they may change your role to fit the needs of the work as well as for the benefit of your process. You must agree to accept the roles and changes in roles assigned to you by the Principal Companies, Resident, and Emerging Choreographers.

There will be absolutely no use of cell phones or laptops during rehearsals. It is strictly prohibited for you to film any of the rehearsals or the showing on June 26th, even for personal review without permission from the Principal Companies, Resident and Emerging Choreographers and Alexandra Wells. If we find that you have filmed or posted on social media without permission, you will be asked to leave the project with no refund.

You must credit Springboard Danse or Springboard Danse Montréal in any biographical material if you should obtain employment, immediately or in the future, with any of the choreographers and companies participating in the project or auditions held at Springboard Danse Montréal.

You may be asked to leave the project if you engage in any unprofessional conduct or do not follow any of the terms and conditions outlined above. If you are removed from the project for any of these reasons, which determination shall be made at the sole discretion of Springboard Danse, you will not receive a refund.

By signing below, you acknowledge that you have read and fully understand this Springboard Danse Montréal 2020 Dancer’s contract, as well as agree to its terms and conditions. You also hereby give your permission for your voice, image and likeness to be used in any merchandise, media or promotional materials in the manner described above.
